Homer Farmers' Market Mission Statement

The Homer Farmers' Market welcomes all local growers of farm, garden and greenhouse produce to participate in a weekly market. The Homer Farmers' Market was established in 2000 to aid in the development of a sustainable local agricultural community for the benefit of the greater Kachemak Bay area.

Market Operation

The Homer Farmers' Market is an open-air market located at 1211 Ocean Drive. Hours of operation will be 10 AM to 3 PM every Saturday starting Memorial Day Weekend and running through the last Saturday in September. Wednesday Markets will be 3 PM to 6 PM starting the first week of July.

- Each vendor will provide his/her own containers and standard method of measurement used in determining price and use proper labeling.
- Vendors are to provide their own sunshade or rain protection, if necessary.
- A table or bench is acceptable for display of products; limited space is also available on a first come/first serve basis for tailgate sales from pickups and station wagons.
- Sale of NON-ALASKAN GROWN produce or NON-ALASKAN MANUFACTURED products will not be permitted. Peddling (resale) is prohibited.
- No sale of livestock or pets is permitted on the premises. Animals are not allowed due to health and safety reasons.
- No sale of baked goods, fish or meat products WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMITS is allowed. Permits MUST be available for inspection on request. NO HOME BAKED GOODS!

Note: All structures must be removed within 2 weeks of YOUR last market. If it's not removed within 2 weeks, your property will be considered abandoned and removed from the lot with a cost of \$50 to you. This will jeopardize your vending for the next season.
